



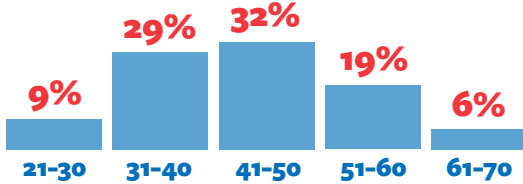

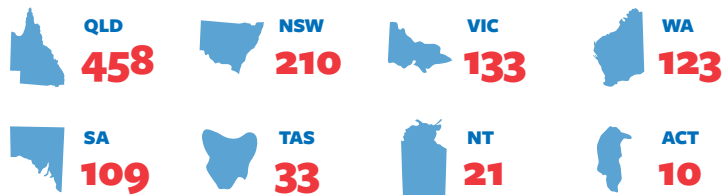

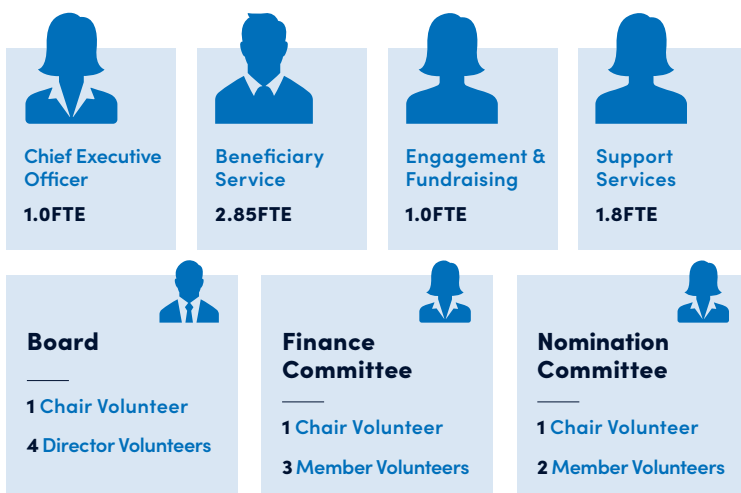

# A Brave Story:

Providing educational opportunities for children, post service, can be difficult. Bravery Trust assisted Jess, a young RAAF veteran recently transitioned, and her three children, with the payment of Year 7 school fees for her daughter and negotiated a waiver of outstanding primary school fees for her other children.

Both Jess and her former husband served in the ADF and were injured due to their time in service. Domestic violence has impacted Jess and her children, meaning that she and her young family have moved a few times in a short time frame which has affected the children immensely.

Financial hardship has impacted the family, but Jess was determined to ensure that her children could go to school. Jess has been a regular at her children's schools; volunteering, cleaning and helping out in any way she can, to ensure that her kids could remain at school, even though she was unable to meet the ongoing fees.

With help from Bravery Trust, Jess and her children are set for school this year and can focus on what is important: spending time together and rebuilding their lives.

Support provided: \$2,513.56 for secondary school fees plus wiping the debt for primary school fees.
